BeyondHousing is a regional Victorian charity and not for profit organisation providing people with a pathway to home. We are working to end homelessness by providing homes for renters who need them and the support they need to keep them.

Every year, we help 6000 individuals and families find and stay in a home of their own.

And, we are building more homes for the families and individuals in our communities who need them.

We are committed to preventing and ending homelessness, addressing housing affordability, and fostering housing stability.

HOW WE HELP

We help people and families experiencing or at risk of homelessness, those who need support and advocacy in private rental homes, and provide support for people living in social housing.

We also own and manage over 700 community housing properties and 3 family violence crisis housing facilities.

SAFE PLACES

BeyondHousing has constructed three crisis housing facilities for women and children escaping family violence in the Mitchell Shire, Goulburn Valley and Northeast regions of Victoria.

We have partnered with local family violence specialist services to make sure women and children have a Safe Place to stay when they are in crisis.

Safe Places provides immediate housing safety for women and children impacted by family violence, enabling access to ongoing supports, and to plan for a long-term home of their own.
