> Community Housing

Well-maintained, affordable housing options for individuals and families on low to moderate incomes across the Ovens Murray and Goulburn regions. We focus on matching renters with suitable homes, fostering long-term sustainable tenancies, and partnering with community organisations to provide additional renter support services.



How it works

- → Rent calculation: As a guideline, should not exceed 30% of total household income.
- → Eligibility: You must qualify for Commonwealth Rent Assistance or Victorian public housing.
- → Application Process: To register for housing, you must apply online using the Victorian Housing Register Application through myGov.

Scan the QR code to go to the myGov website. Sign in or create an account, it should only take a few minutes.



- Go to 'My Account' and select 'Linked Services'
- Scroll down the list to 'HousingVic Online Services'
- Click 'Link' and open 'HousingVic Online Services'
- Select 'Victorian Housing Register application', fill it out and attach any required documents (a copy will be emailed to you)

If you don't want to apply online, we can assist you in completing a 'Register of Interest Application' at one of our offices.
